

Year End Award Rules & Nomination Blanks

Rules:

- 1. Must be a current member of the Illinois Appaloosa Association.
- 2. Horses, Non-Pro, & Youth must be nominated before showing (No Fee Required). Nominations must be turned in before your first class shows to any IAA Officer or Director. A box will be provided in the show office of any show put on by IAA for your nominations or mail to address below.
- 3. Classes appearing on the Get Spotted Show Bill will be the classes for which Year End Awards will be given plus Weanling, Yearling Longe Line, and 2 Year Old Snaffle Bit classes which can't be held before May 20, and High Point Overall Awards for 13 & under Youth, 14-18 Youth, Novice Youth 18 & under, Walk-Trot 10 & under, Non-Pro 19 & over, Limited Non-Pro 35 & over, Masters Non-Pro 50 & over, Novice Non-Pro and Walk Trot Non-Pro if participation in all these areas warrants all awards
- 4. Only points earned at IAA approved shows will count for awards and World Show Slips.
- 5. Points Tabulated as follows (according to how many placings are on the ApHC Judges Cards, currently 8 placings, if changed our point system will change accordingly.): 1st-8 pts; 2nd-7 pts, 3rd-6 pts, 4th-5 pts, 5th-4 pts, 6th-3 pts, 7th-2pts, 8th-1pt. IAA Sponsored or Co-Sponsored shows will receive double points. Single Judge shows sponsored by IAA will receive double points plus 5 bonus points for each class entered in.
- 6. For each class your highest point values will count from ½ the judges of IAA approved shows plus 1 with the maximum of 12 judges placings.

Example: If we approve 6 shows with 12 judges total, the number of placings available for points to count would be 6 plus 1 for total of 7. If we approve 15 shows with 30 judges total, the number of placings available for points to count would be only 12, because ½ of 30 plus 1 is over 12 and the maximum is 12.

Notice all current year member's horses are eligible for World Slips, but only nominated horses are eligible for Year End Awards.
